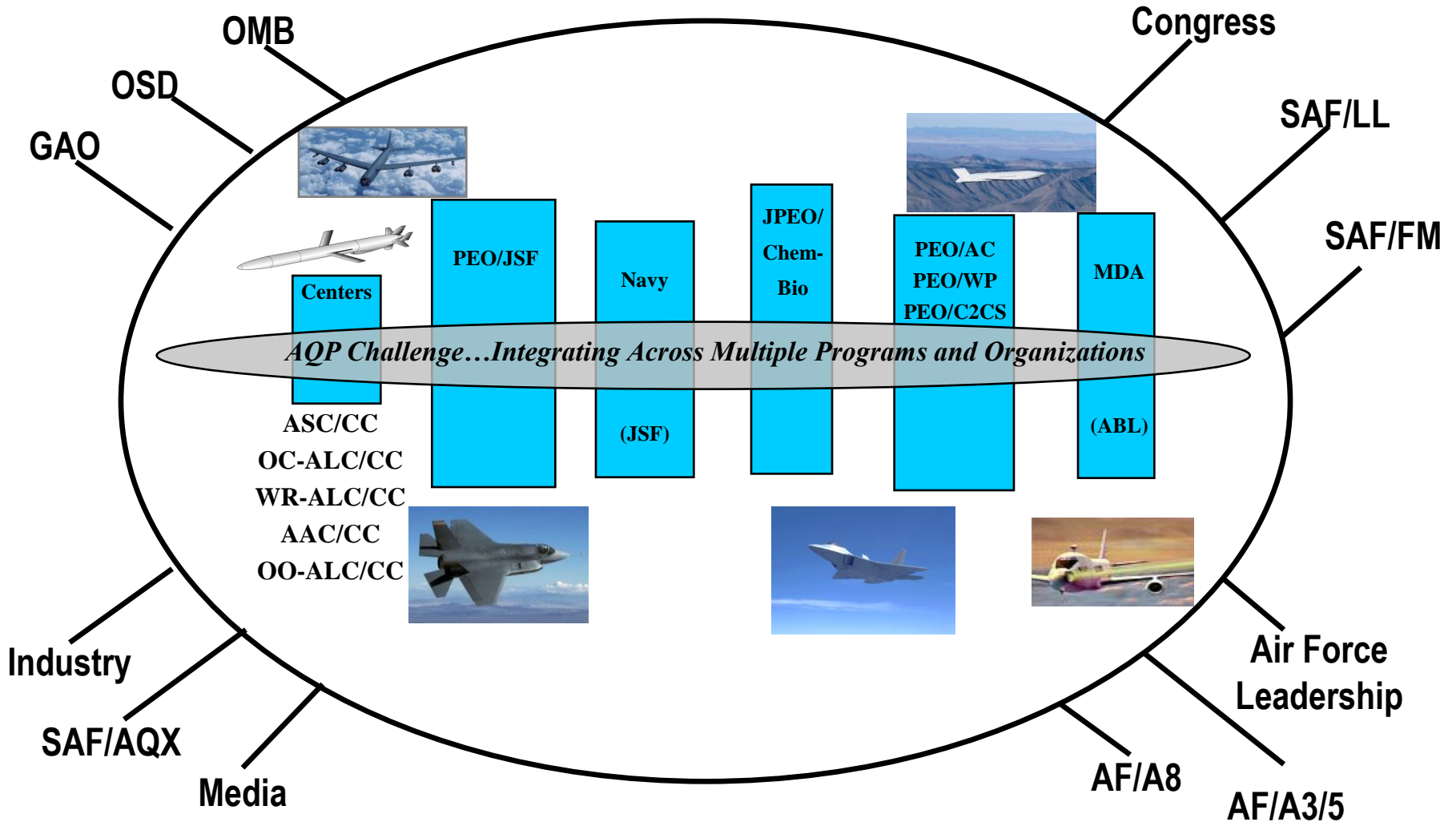

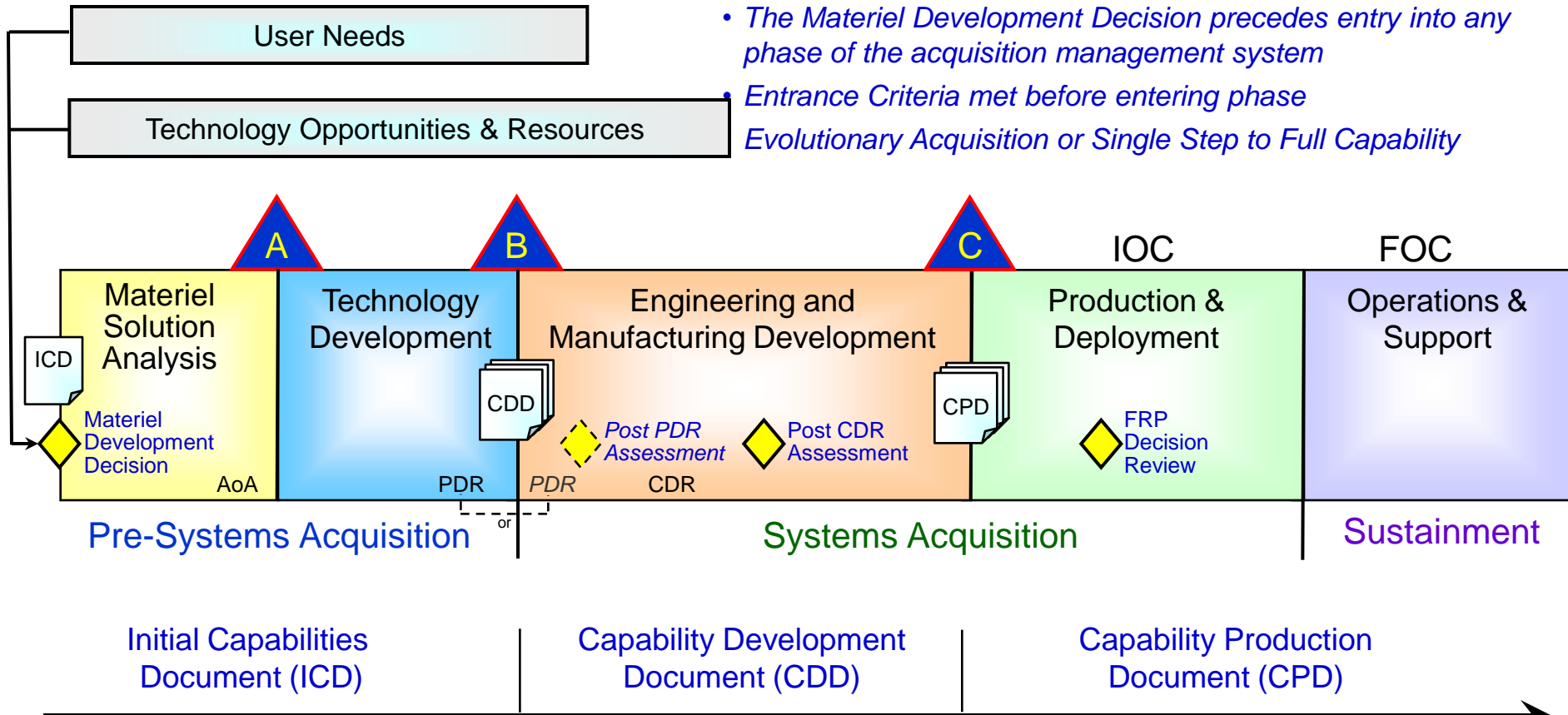

- The Materiel Development Decision precedes entry into any phase of the acquisition management system
- Entrance Criteria met before entering phase
- Evolutionary Acquisition or Single Step to Full Capability

PDR: Preliminary Design Review
 CDR: Critical Design Review
 FRP: Full Rate Production

IOC: Initial Operational Capability
 FOC: Full Operational Capability
